- Calling for accreditation of organisations with the Tamilnadu Medical
Council for conducting approved Continuing Medical Education (CME)
with credit hours for the period 2018-2023 - Notification Issued-
Regarding.

The Tamilnadu Medical Council hereby call for applications from Universities, recognized Medical Colleges, Professional Associations, Specialist Associations, IMA (National, State and Branches), National Academy of Medical Sciences, Specialists and Super Specialist Associations(National, State or Regional level), Postgraduate Medical Institutions, Central and State Govt. Hospitals, State Level Medical Organizations of Repute, Private Medical Institutions with Multispeciality departments, Private Medical Institutions registered as Trust etc for accreditation with the Council to hold approved Continuing Medical Education (CME) programmes with credit hours for the participants for the period 2018-2023.

The accreditation process will be done from 21.05.2018 to 20.06.2018. The Application Format and the instructions / rules are attached to this Notification and also can be downloaded from the Tamil Nadu Medical Council Website www.tnmedicalcouncil.org.

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**GUIDELINES FOR ACCREDITATION OF ORGANISATIONS FOR CONDUCTING
C.M.E. WITH CREDIT HOURS APPROVED BY TNMC
FOR THE PERIOD 2018-2023.**

1. Starting on 21-05-2018 will be completed by 20-06-2018.
2. Accreditations valid for 5 years.
3. All organization already accredited should renew for the same next 5 years.
4. The fees for accreditation will be Rs.10,000/- per organization for a period of 5 years.
(smaller IMA branches can apply for concession).
5. These accredited organisations can hold any number of C.M.E.s (Based on the guidelines of MCI/TNMC) in the next 5 years.
6. These organizations will be allocated E-mail id by TNMC.
7. For every CME, they should intimate the TNMC of the programme in the prescribed format, 72 hours prior to the CME, through the designated Mail id.
8. The same to send details of attendance as Xerox copy and in prescribed format within 48 hours on completion of CME through the designated Mail id.
9. These organizations should pay Rs 50 per participant as crediting fees as DD to TNMC within 5 days. (for those holding regular/ monthly 2 hourly CMEs apply for Rs 25 per participant)
10. TNMC will credit the CME hours within 72 hours (on working days) on receipt of the details and fees. The same will be conveyed to the individual by a SMS from council and updated against their names in TNMC website.
11. No certificates will be issued to doctors registered in this Council. Certificates will be issued by TNMC to the organization/ institution for doctors from other states or on special requests.
12. Accredited organizations can issue attendance slips (serially numbered with counterfoil) to all participants.
13. Council can do surprise inspection of the CME's or verify any documents and records related to the CME by its observers.
14. All accredited organization will be issued an authorization certificate by the Council for the purpose.
